- Tools and objects will be secured to prevent falling.
- Housekeeping in the allocated work area will be well maintained.
- Only approved elevated platforms will be used.
- If a work method requires detach and re-attach at height, a dual lanyard system will be used to ensure one connection point is maintained at all times.
- Any Electrical work that requires a permanent style connection will be carried out by a qualified electrician with a current practicing licence.
- The supply cable will have adequate mechanical protection.
- The supply cable and plug will be of adequate size for the load.
- The supply cable will be situated to remove any chance of causing a tripping hazard.
- The supply lead has now and will have during the event a current test tag.
- Hold public liability insurance for the activities proposed in this form for a value no less than NZD\$10 million
